The juridical "family".- This is the different specialities in Law that work with independence in each European Country. The European Union Constitution made, for example, necessary the union between the different specialists in Law.

Until this moment only the non positivist topics: Philosophy of Law, Sociology of Law, History of Law, History of the Political Ideas...have groups of discussion in Europa of very broad aspect.

There is a need that Constitutionalists, Civilists, Penal Law specialists, Commercial Law...made joint arrangements to elaborate joint discussions and teaching that prepare the future lawyers and judges, jurists in general, with attention to generate abilities for the exercise of the citizen's rights.

Until this moment the juridical needs made reference only to the law of every country. The Bologna procedure requires the formation of professionals that can exercise in all European countries. It needs of new islands of knowledge in the legal areas
